


















Significant Incidents:

Round Lake Crews were dispatched to 15 structure fires in October. Of these, 5 were indistrict and two were significant:

Wednesday, October 4th @ 7:47 pm:

Crews were dispatched to a reported structure fire in the 1600 block of S. Amarias Drive in Round Lake.

Battalion 26 arrived first and found light smoke coming out of the front of the residence. Further investigation found a working kitchen fire in the rear of the residence.

Crews extended a 1¾" attack line through the house and extinguished the fire within 10 minutes. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters.

Our crews were assisted at the scene by crews from Grayslake, Fox Lake, and Wauconda.

Tuesday, October 17th @ 8:44 pm:

Crews were dispatched to a report of a structure fire in the 200 block of E. Pineview Drive in Hainesville.

Battalion 26 arrived first and reported smoke showing from a 2-story single family residence.

Engine 262 arrived and advanced an attack line into the structure and found a room and contents fire in the dining room area of the residence. They applied water to the fire and brought it under control within 10 minutes. There were no injuries to firefighters or civilians.

Our crews were assisted at the scene by crews from Grayslake, Fox Lake, and Wauconda.
