## Emergency Responses by Type:









### Response Time - EMS

**Significant Incidents:**

Round Lake Crews were dispatched to 12 structure fires in June. Of these, 4 were in-district and none were significant. There were several significant EMS incidents in June, including:

- A motorcycle accident involving a 37 year-old male who apparently collided with and was pinned under a vehicle. Our crews successfully extricated him from under the vehicle in critical condition and delivered ALS care during transport to Condell Medical Center.
- While performing work from a bucket truck, a Comed Lineman accidentally came into contact with a 12 KV power line and became unconscious. His co-worker recognized that he was not breathing, called 911 and began performing CPR. Our crew arrived and took over care and initiated ALS measures that successfully restored a viable heart rhythm and breathing. He was transported to Condell Medical Center.
